The City of Berea is pleased to provide *Dinner to Your Door*, a program that delivers meals to the homes of seniors, disabled and shut-in residents. Our service includes the cities of Berea, Brook Park and Middleburg Heights.

Each freshly prepared meal costs \$6.00. We accept self-pay only by check or money order. We provide dinner only (no breakfast, lunch or beverages) and each meal includes a protein, starch vegetable, fruit cup and a dessert. Meals can be ordered for only one day of the week or for as many days of the week as the resident prefers. Our caterer makes seven different meals each week.

Meals are delivered to the home Monday-Friday between 1:30-3:30 p.m. Our volunteers have received the COVID vaccine so it is your choice if you want them to knock on the door and hand you the meal or you can leave a cooler and ice pack out so the volunteer can safely store your dinner. The volunteer will knock and/or ring the doorbell to alert you of the delivery.

If a resident orders seven days of meals, Dinner to Your Door will deliver on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, which will include a meal for Saturday and Sunday.

Invoices will be mailed out at the end of the month and may be paid by check or money order made out to BCDC (Berea Community Development Corporation is the non-profit that funds the Dinner to Your Door program).

Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate special diets, however, we will take every precaution with allergies. When you fill out the application, please be sure to indicate any food allergies.

We do not provide a calendar of meals. The dinners include a wide variety such as pork kabobs, breaded or roasted chicken, meatloaf, roast beef, breaded fish filets, spaghetti and meatballs, eggplant parmesan, pasta and much more.
