Ordinance No. 2018-15

AN ORDINANCE

RENAMING AND REESTABLISHING THE CITY OF BEREAL MUNICIPAL COURT FUND, KNOWN AS FUND NO. 281, TO THE GENERAL FUND-DESIGNATED MUNICIPAL COURT FUND, TO BE KNOWN AS FUND NO. 181, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2012-86 established the Municipal Court Fund, known as Fund No. 281, in order to account for funds received and expended for Municipal Court Operations, and properly account for all disbursements therefrom; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court Fund, known as Fund No. 281, is being renamed and reestablished, and will hereafter be named the General Fund-Designated Municipal Court Fund, and be known as Fund No. 181.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 1901.36, the Director of Finance of the City of Berea be and she is hereby authorized and directed to reestablish and rename the Municipal Court Fund, which shall hereafter be named the General Fund-Designated Municipal Court Fund, and which will be designated for accounting purposes as Fund No. 181.

**SECTION 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that it is necessary and proper to rename this fund so that it will align with the 2018 Budget which must be adopted on or before March 31, 2018. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
