AN ORDINANCE

## APPOINTING DALE LANGE TO THE BEREAL TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL (TIRC) PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 5709 OF THE REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Chapter 5709 of the Revised Code requires that a Tax Incentive Review Council (TIRC) be established to review real property tax abatement for commercial and industrial properties in the City; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2010-9 was adopted by Council on February 16, 2010 and signed by the Mayor on February 17, 2010, establishing the City of Berea Tax Incentive Review Council pursuant to 5709.85(A)(2) of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 5709.85(A)(2), members are required to be appointed by various government entities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Berea is required to appoint two members from each municipal corporation to serve a three-year term; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor wishes to appoint Dale Lange, a Berea resident, to the Tax Incentive Review Council.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That in accordance with 5709.85(A)(2), Dale Lange be appointed to serve on the City of Berea Tax Incentive Review Council for a three-year term commencing on the earliest date allowed by law.

**SECTION 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that the Cuyahoga County TIRC Chair has just requested the resumes of all new appointees by the end of April. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
