ORDINANCE No. 2019-4

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO ONE OR MORE AGREEMENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE REGIONAL STORMWATER COMMUNITY COST-SHARE PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A STREET SWEEPER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Community Cost-Share Program, administered by the Northeast Ohio Sewer District, provides funds for the construction, operation, and maintenance of the local stormwater system or Regional Stormwater System, including administrative costs directly associated with such projects, as well as costs related to repair or upgrade; and

WHEREAS, the City has applied for, and been approved to receive, funding for the purchase of a street sweeper in the amount of Two Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand, Two Hundred Forty Dollars (\$298,240).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service is authorized to enter into one or more agreements with the Northeast Regional Sewer District to facilitate the City's participation in the Regional Stormwater Community Cost-Share Program for the purpose of purchasing a street sweeper.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to pay out such contract sum(s) and charge the same to, and the funds therefor are hereby appropriated from Sewer Capital Improvement Fund, designated for accounting purposes as Fund No. 420 and the Sewer Revenue Fund, designated for accounting purposes as Fund No. 520, for the purposes set forth in Section 1 hereinabove.



SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that the street sweeper is essential for the City's sanitary and storm sewer maintenance program. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


