### A RESOLUTION

#### HONORING, COMMENDING AND CELEBRATING THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS (VFW) POST 6676 ON THE 30<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF ITS SERVICE TO THE CITY OF BERE, OHIO.

**WHEREAS**, the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) is a nonprofit Veterans service organization comprised of eligible Veterans and Military Service Members from the Active, Guard and Reserve Forces; and

**WHEREAS**, some of the core values of the VFW include promoting patriotism, honoring military service, ensuring the care of Veterans and their families, putting the needs of Members first, treating donors as partners and serving communities; and

**WHEREAS**, local VFW Post 6676 has been serving the community of Bere, Ohio since January of 1989, and currently lists 475 individuals as Members; and

**WHEREAS**, VFW Post 6676 has, for the past 30 years, sponsored and promoted numerous programs and services throughout the City of Bere in an effort to foster camaraderie amongst local Veterans of overseas conflicts, support local Veterans, Service Members and their Families, advocate on behalf of all Veterans and serve the local community; and

**WHEREAS**, VFW Post 6676 has supported countless community events and activities that have benefitted City schools and scholarship drives, youth organizations, local law enforcement, families of need and the Special Olympics.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Bere, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor of the City of Bere, the President and all of the Members of Council, and the Officers of the Administration do hereby honor, commend and celebrate VFW Post 6676 on the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of its service to the City and, with grateful hearts, extend our most sincere thanks for its efforts, accomplishments and contributions to our Veterans and to our community.




