WHEREAS, as one nominator stated, Ms. Moes "is a never-ending model of what it means to truly invest yourself in the customer and the community we serve."


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.




