A RESOLUTION

HONORING, COMMENDING AND CELEBRATING LAURA UPSON ON BEING NAMED A 2019 RECIPIENT OF THE BEREAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE COURTESY AWARD.



SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.




