## AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO ONE OR MORE CONTRACT(S) FOR THE PURCHASE OF VARIOUS PRODUCTS AND SERVICES FOR THE DAY-TO-DAY OPERATIONS OF THE CITY OF BEREAS SERVICE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids and, after approval by the Board of Control, to enter into one or more contracts for 2018 with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s) for the purchase of various products and services for the day-to-day operations of the City's Service Department, all in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, and ratifying the same.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


