A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR, AND, IF AWARDED, TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE 2025 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM AND TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO ONE OR MORE CONTRACTS FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THE CDSG AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Cuyahoga Council created the Cuyahoga County Supplemental Block Grant program administered in conjunction with, and using the same grant process as, the County Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Supplemental Block Grant program is funded through the Casino Revenue Fund, distributed by Cuyahoga County and administered by the Cuyahoga County Department of Development; and

WHEREAS, application projects must meet a community development need related to the health or welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, the project(s) to be submitted by the City of Berea for consideration in the competitive process are identified on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to make application for and, if awarded, to enter into a Cooperation Agreement with the County Executive of Cuyahoga County and the Department of Development for the Cuyahoga County Supplemental Grant program for 2025, providing for the use of Cuyahoga County Supplemental Grant Program funds on the projects identified on Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That upon entering into the Cooperative Agreement with the County Executive of Cuyahoga County and the Department of Development for the Community Supplemental Block Grant Program for year 2025, the Mayor shall be authorized to advertise for bids and to enter into one or more contracts to perform the work specified in the CDSG award.

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SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the approval of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that the City must meet the filing deadline in order to be considered eligible to receive the grant funds. Therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage an approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Exhibit A

City of Berea – 2025 CDSG Application Edgewood Drive Improvement Project

Project Description

This project will accomplish improvements to Edgewood Drive from Lindbergh Boulevard to Crescent Drive within the City of Berea. Work will include resurfacing of the road, sidewalk and apron replacement as needed, and drainage improvements. The existing pavement will be resurfaced including milling the existing asphalt and the installation of two layers of asphalt pavement. Base pavement and ADA Ramps will be replaced on an as-needed basis. Any existing manholes, catch basins, water valve boxes, and monument boxes in need of repair will be reconstructed. Any sidewalks or aprons in need of repair or that are disturbed during the project will be replaced. Storm sewers will be extended, and underdrains will be installed to improve surface and subsurface drainage.

The City will apply for \$50,000 in grant funds through the 2025 Cuyahoga County Supplemental Grant Program (CDSG). If the grant is awarded, construction will take place between April and December 2025 during the CDSG Program Term. The project is expected to take 60 to 90 days to complete.
