AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO ONE OR MORE CONTRACTS FOR THE LONGBROOKE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, APPROPRIATING THE FUNDS THEREFORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council finds that the condition of several cul-de-sacs in the Longbrooke development have substantially deteriorated and will require reconstruction in order to remain safe for vehicle and bicycle traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids and, upon approval of the Board of Control, to enter into one or more contracts with the lowest, most responsive and responsible bidder(s) for the Longbrooke Reconstruction Project, to include the reconstruction of the following cul-de-sacs, in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Service: Brighton Circle (north & south), Perham Circle (north & south), Crossbrook Circle (south of Merrimak Drive), Tauton Circle (north and south), Duxbury Circle and Putney Circle.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to pay out such contract sum(s) and charge the same to, and the funds therefore are hereby appropriated from, the General Improvement Fund, designated for accounting purposes as Fund No. 400, for the purposes set forth in Section 1 hereinabove.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that the condition of the cul-de-sacs mentioned herein have deteriorated to the point that if not reconstructed in a timely manner, they may soon present a safety risk to the traveling public.

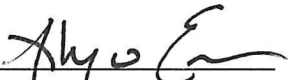
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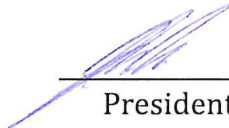
Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
