## RESOLUTION NO. 2025-19

### HONORING DEIONNA BORDERS ON SECURING THE 2025 DIVISION I GIRLS STATE WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIP IN THE 235-POUND WEIGHT CLASS, APPLAUDING HER UNDEFEATED SEASON AND CELEBRATING THE FIRST EVER OHSAA CHAMPIONSHIP FOR BEREAL-MIDPARK HIGH SCHOOL.

**WHEREAS**, Deionna Borders, a Berea resident and junior at Berea-Midpark High School, has earned the title of 2025 Division I Girls State Wrestling Champion in the 235-pound weight class; and

**WHEREAS**, Deionna was introduced to wrestling by Coach Steve Bosko, fell in love with the sport immediately, and has been a member of the Girls Wrestling Team since its founding at the high school; and

**WHEREAS**, Deionna credits her success to the tremendous support of her Parents, and particularly to her Coach, Steve Vaughn, saying that she is where she is now because of him; and

**WHEREAS**, when asked about Deionna's success, Coach Vaughn noted her incredible athleticism, but clarified that she is a champion because of her attitude, work ethic, coachability, determination and dedication, adding that Deionna is genuinely eager to learn, and he has greatly enjoyed watching her grow as a wrestler and getting to know her as a person; and

**WHEREAS**, Deionna is also a tremendous teammate who inspires her fellow wrestlers, cheers on their efforts and successes, and lead the team to a season full of record setting performances that included 6 District Qualifies, 2 State Qualifiers and Berea-Midpark High School's first ever OHSAA State Champion; and

**WHEREAS**, while Deionna currently participates with Team Ohio in National Duals, and Beat the Streets Cleveland throughout other States, she plans to pursue her wrestling career in college, with the goal of one day wrestling as a member of the US Olympic team; and

**WHEREAS**, through her hard work, passion and determination, and with the guidance, assistance and support of her Parents and Coaches, Deionna has achieved her goal of Girls State Wrestling Champion in the heavyweight division, while simultaneously securing the respect, admiration and pride of her fellow students and teammates, teachers and Coaches, and residents of the City of Berea and beyond.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:




