**WHEREAS**, the Members of City Council wish to thank Chief Schultz for being a longtime public servant, friend and protector of the community; and



**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:



**SECTION 2.** That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


