WHEREAS, the Members of City Council wish to thank Chief Schultz for being a longtime public servant, friend and protector of the community; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bereal, State of Ohio:



SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.




