A RESOLUTION

CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF MASON KAHL TO THE MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Berea Codified Ordinance 327.03(b) requires that appointments to the Municipal Planning Commission, made by the Mayor, be confirmed by City Council; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Kleem has appointed Mason Kahl, a Berea resident, to the Municipal Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Mason Kahl received a bachelor's degree in Economic Development from Cleveland State University in December 2024; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kahl currently serves as the Coordinator of Project and Site Strategies for Team NEO, an organization devoted to advancing the Northeast Ohio Region toward a vibrant economy; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kahl previously served as an intern in the City of Berea Department of Economic Development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Berea hereby approves the appointment of Mason Kahl to the Municipal Planning Commission for the unexpired term of Manoj Joseph.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the approval of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that it is necessary to have members appointed to the Commission in order that they may begin

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their work. Therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

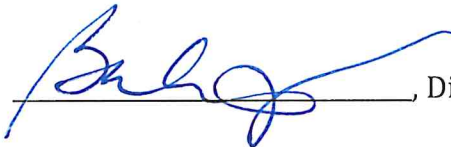
