SMOKE DETECTORS – CERTIFICATION REQUIRED: It has been our experience that in some cases, tenants have disconnected, covered over, or rendered them inoperable. You are required to conduct an inspection of the smoke detector units located in your apartments to ensure that they are operable and to sign the certification below.

CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS/ALARMS REQUIRED: Effective July 1, 2014, pursuant to the Residential Code of Ohio & the Ohio Building Code Sections 315, approved carbon monoxide alarms shall be installed outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the sleeping rooms in those dwelling units.

- Having fuel-fired appliances
- Attached garage
- Where an application for approval is required for work involving any of the following areas:
 1. The addition or creation of a new sleeping room
 2. An alteration of a sleeping room
 3. An alteration in the immediate vicinity outside of a sleeping room
 4. An addition of, or an alteration to, an attached garage
 5. An addition, alteration, repair or replacement of a fuel-fired appliance

As the owner of the property/dwelling units set forth in this application, I hereby state, under oath, that:

1. I hereby certify that the smoke detectors installed in the dwelling units located at the property which are the subject of this application were inspected on _____, and are, to the best of my knowledge, operable;
2. I hereby certify that, on or after July 1, 2014, approved carbon monoxide detectors/alarms were installed pursuant to the Residential Code of Ohio & the Ohio Building Code Sections 315;
3. I understand that:
 - a. *In the event there is a change in the resident agent or nonresident agent as shown by the certificate of occupancy, the owner shall notify the Building Inspector in writing within thirty days of such change, giving the name and address of the new resident agent or nonresident agent.*
 - b. *In the event there is a change in ownership of record, the certificate of occupancy issued under the provisions of this Housing Code to the former owner shall become null and void within thirty days of the recorded date of such change of ownership and a new certificate of occupancy must be obtained by the new owner. Application for such new certificate of occupancy must be obtained by the new owner.*
 - c. *Any change in the nature or extent of the use or occupancy as specified on the certificate of occupancy shall render the certificate of occupancy null and void upon the occurrence of such change. No such change is permissible under this Housing Code unless such change has been approved by the proper City authorities pursuant to this Housing Code and unless a new certificate of occupancy, incorporating such change, has been issued. Any such change without the approval of the proper City authorities will subject the owner, operator or agent to the penalties provided in this Housing Code.*
4. That the property/dwelling unit satisfies the provisions of Part 13 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Berea (housing code).

I certify that the information given herein is true and complete to the best of my knowledge. I realize that any false or misleading information may subject me to prosecution under Ohio Revised Code Sections 2921.13(A)(3),(A)(5) or 2921.13(A)(6).
