## AN ORDINANCE

### AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A F.E.M.A. ASSISTANCE-TO-FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FOR ACQUISITION OF A SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS (SCBA) FILL STATION AND LARGE DIAMETER HOSE FOR THE BEREAL FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has submitted a request for grant funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (F.E.M.A.) for its Fiscal Year 2012 Grant Program for new equipment for the Fire Department consisting of an SCBA Fill Station and large diameter hose and the same has tentatively been awarded by F.E.M.A. to the City of Berea.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Berea, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Grant Application submitted by the City to F.E.M.A. for Fiscal Year 2012 is hereby ratified and affirmed and the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept said grant moneys in the estimated amount of nine-five percent (95%) of \$80,710.00 (the cost of the equipment).

**SECTION 2.** That the City's contribution shall be five percent (5%) of the cost of the equipment (i.e. approximately \$4,035.00).

**SECTION 3.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


**SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to comply with the terms and time limits of the grant established by F.E.M.A. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


